

Come to the Valley Shenandoah Valley

Virginia *Updated!*

October 9-11, 2015

Eastern/Midwest Fall Regional



We will stay at the Holiday Inn Harrisonburg, VA – 1 hour drive from Charlottesville, VA; 2 hours from Dulles Airport; some train service to nearby Staunton; some flights to Shenandoah Regional Airport.

Nearby - Shenandoah National Park, George Washington National Forest, Blue Ridge Mountains, Appalachians, Shenandoah River; The Heritage Museum (Harrisonburg-Rockingham Historical Society), in Dayton, VA, with an Electric Map of Stonewall Jackson's famous Valley Campaign; plenty of Civil War history, such as at New Market, VA – Battle of New Market, National Historic Landmark; and Shenandoah Caverns (with elevator service!) and History of American Celebration on Parade (floats from the Rose Parades, Inaugural Parades and more); Luray Caverns is also nearby.

Take a guided tour - The Virginia Museum of the Civil War (VMCW) interprets the 1864 Battle of New Market with emphasis on the role of Virginia Military Institute Cadets and the Civil War in Virginia. Part of Virginia Military Institute museums which includes the VMCW, V.M.I. Museum and the Stonewall Jackson House. (On May 10, 1864, the VMI Corps of Cadets was ordered to join Gen. John C. Breckinridge's Confederate forces near Staunton, Virginia. After marching nearly 85 miles northward, the Corps arrived at New Market on Sunday morning May 15, 1864. The battlefield became known as the "Field of Lost Shoes", as seen in the Emmy-winning film.)

Come early, there is plenty to do!

Staunton, the "Best Small Town in America": Unscathed by the civil war happening all around, the historic architecture; Woodrow Wilson Presidential Library & Museum, Trinity Episcopal Church (with over 25 majestic stained glass windows, including 12 Tiffany Windows; founded in 1746; current building constructed in 1855; served as the Virginia state capitol for 16 days in 1781), St Francis of Assisi Catholic Church (parish founded 1845), Camera Heritage Museum, Museum of Bank History, and more.
